



Body Interact



At this years ILC, I, Jeremiah Stemm(left), lead my team with Evan Young(middle) and Reese Billingsley(right) in the Body Interact Tournament. Body Interact is a clinical program software that allows students to treat virtual patients under different settings (Pre-Hospital, Emergency Room, Consultation).

The patients in each scenario have varying medical problems and one will never know what scenario they will get. Based on Body Interact's physiological algorithm, the patient's condition progresses over time.

My team and I had to determine our own diagnosis and treatment plan while having to act swiftly to save the patients life.

On top of that we very given the opportunity to visualize the effects of the actions we took. We had to read visual and audible symptoms, dynamic dialogue, and monitor the patients vital signs in real-time. With a library of over 700+ virtual patient scenarios, me and my team couldn't just practice what to do in one instance, we had to know medically what needed to happen in ANY instance. This includes 80+ physical exams, 290+ complimentary exams (electrophysiology, imaging, lab tests, decision aids, and more), 200+ interventions (safety measures, position patients, etc) 600+ medications and prescriptions that the software will allow us to do.

We practiced so much, and after each simulation, detailed reports are available to help evaluate and reflect on our individual or group performance, as well as identify and understand correct and incorrect decisions. After hours of discussions, practice, clinical research, and memorization I am proud to say that we are International Champions. We placed 1st at HOSA's Body Interact Tournament. Along with this prestigious award, we received a grant for our school to use this program in classrooms, totalling a quantity of \$5,650.
