

Simplified Checklist of Requirements to Offer a CCPE

- □ Individual Student Career Planning Tool/Process in-place and active
- Transitional Math and Transitional English courses offered to students as appropriate
- □ Course Sequence specifically focused on the Career Pathway
 - □ At least two years of coursework
 - Early College Credit Classes that are specifically aligned with the Career Pathway (not general education courses) and that offer at least 6 credit hours
- At least two <u>Team-Based Challenges</u> in which students engage in an authentic challenge and interact with a professional as a mentor during the challenge
- Completes a 60-hour internship experience (which can be divided into 2 30-hour micro-internship experiences, if necessary)

CCPE - Total Number of Endorsements by Year



Career and Technical Student Organizations (CTSOs) - Funding

Through the Perkins and Career and Technical Education Improvement (CTEI) allocation to the EFE and school districts, it is allowable in their grant to use funds for nationally and Illinois recognized CTSOs that are aligned to approved secondary CTE programs, are advised by appropriately licensed CTE teachers, and have CTE student members.

Allowed – EFE Allocations

- Schools participating in approved secondary CTE programs
 - Transportation
 - Membership Special population
 - Student's registration/fees SLC/ILC
 - Advisor
 - Professional Development
 - Attend national conference
 - New CTSO's (Chapter Adviser)
- Memberships, Subscriptions, and Professional Activity Costs
 - CTE-related School District

Not Allowed

- Student hotel costs
- Membership regular students
- Out-of-state travel for students
- Individual Memberships, Subscriptions, and Professional Activity Costs
